How to properly test your WH Security system

WH Security encourages customers to test their alarm systems monthly. Testing your alarm system can be very beneficial since it ensures your system is working properly, as well as confirms proper connectivity and communication to the monitoring facility. On occasion, outside interruptions such as storms or phone line failures can cause your alarm to malfunction. Follow these steps to test your system and eliminate these concerns:

1. Begin by calling the monitoring center and telling them to place your system on "test" mode.
2. Then, arm your alarm system just like you would normally do when you leave your property. After arming the system, wait for the delay time to expire.



Test your alarm system each month to ensure it is working properly.

3. Go around your house and open and close doors or windows that have sensors connected to the system. If the system is working correctly, this will cause an alarm to activate. While the system is armed, as you're walking around the house, your movements will also trigger the motion detectors if you have these on the system.

4. After you've inspected all of your sensors, disarm the alarm system as you normally would when you return home.

5. Finally, call the monitoring center again to verify that the alarm signals sent by the security system were received, and to take your system off test mode.

General Safety:

- Be sure that your child knows his/her phone number, address and a parent's cell phone number.
- Be sure that your child knows how to call 9-1-1 for emergencies.

Bus Safety:

- If your child rides on a school bus, make sure they wait for the bus to make a complete stop before approaching it from the curb.
- Remind your child to always cross in front of the bus so the driver can see him/her.
- Remind your child that it is not safe to stand until the school bus has completely stopped.

Walking Safety:

- Teach your child not to accept rides or walk with strangers unless you have given him/her permission.
- Have a discussion with your child about what to do if they are approached by a stranger.

After-School Safety:

- When talking to your child about being at home alone, remind them to lock doors and keep windows closed.
- Identify neighbors' homes where your child can go to in the event of an emergency.
