KNOW WHEN CO LEVELS ARE HEIGHTENED IN YOUR HOME

The winter months are the most common time for carbon monoxide (CO) poisoning incidents to occur. In fact, 10 people living in a Saint Paul, Minnesota, duplex were sent to the hospital on New Year's Day after experiencing symptoms of CO poisoning. Police reports noted that CO detectors were missing and disabled in the home.

CO is a poisonous, colorless, odorless and tasteless gas. At high levels, CO can be dangerous to human health and even threaten your life, but a monitored CO sensor in your home can alert you to this danger. WH Security's CO sensors monitor the air quality inside your home. If CO is detected at any time, our local 24/7 monitoring center will contact the home owner immediately and dispatch emergency vehicles if needed.

TO PROTECT YOUR FAMILY THIS WINTER:

- Make sure that air vents are not blocked.
- Do not use a gas oven to heat your home for any length of time.
- When idling a car, back it out of the garage so fumes do not build up in your garage and in the living area of your home.
- Do not sleep in a room with an unvented gas or kerosene space heater.
- Do not use any gasoline-powered engines (mowers, weed trimmers, snow blowers, chain saws, small engines or generators) in enclosed spaces.
- Never ignore symptoms, particularly if more than one person is feeling them. If CO poisoning is suspected, exit the space immediately and call 911.
